1. The totality of our <u>deadness</u>.

2. The totality of His <u>forgiveness</u>

- Forgiveness is not excusing.

- Forgiveness is <u>exchanging</u>.

3. The totality of His sacrifice.

For Christ also suffered for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, that He might bring you to God, after being put to death in the fleshly realm but made alive in the spiritual realm. 1 Peter 318

4. The totality of His <u>victory</u>.
